

about the school **ABOUT THE SCHOOL**

The Wolfpack Golf School, featuring North Carolina State University coaches and players, is entering its twenty-second year with the continuing purpose of promoting Junior golf and helping develop the talent of young golfers. An outstanding curriculum of practice, play and fun is planned.

Students will participate in different kinds of competition according to skill level and age with each student completing rotations which cover every phase of the game. The full week of golf will include individual and group instruction, video analysis, course strategy and management, rules, psychology, club fitting and tournament preparation.



An outstanding staff of PGA professionals, college coaches, and college golfers has been assembled. Their expert instruction is matched only by their dedication to junior golf.



golf facilities **GOLF FACILITIES**

Wildwood Green Golf Club will serve as one host facility. Located in Raleigh, N.C., Wildwood Green is easily accessible from all major roads and highways and only four miles from Raleigh-Durham International Airport. The 18-hole championship layout underwent a \$1.5 million redesign and renovation in 1996. One of the finest tests of golf in the area, Wildwood Green has a driving range with tees at both ends, pitching areas, chipping greens, sand bunkers, two G-2 bentgrass practice putting greens and one bermuda putting green. The golf course has G-2 bentgrass greens and bermuda fairways and has hosted several prestigious tournaments including the Hooters Golf Tour Triangle Classic, Durham Herald-Sun Amateur, and U.S. Amateur Qualifying.

The new Lonnie Poole Golf Course at NC State University will serve as the other host facility. Located on the Centennial Campus just off I-40, this stunning layout designed by Arnold Palmer Golf Design is an 18-hole championship course with great views of downtown Raleigh.

The course serves as the home of the men's and women's varsity golf teams, is a living laboratory for the top-ranked Turfgrass program, and is a teaching and training facility for the Professional Golf Management Program. The golf course has bentgrass greens and bermuda fairways. There is a state of the art practice area with tees at both ends.

golf attire **GOLF ATTIRE**

Proper golf attire is requested for all students while at Wildwood Green Golf Club and Lonnie Poole Golf Course at NC State University. Bermuda style shorts are permitted. Shirts with a collar are required but T-shirts are permitted during golf school weeks due to potentially hot weather and ages of the students. Golf shoes are preferred but not required. All students not wearing golf shoes should wear tennis shoes; please do not wear baseball or soccer cleats. All golf shoes must have non-metal spikes. We will be outside most of the day so suntan lotion or sunscreen may be needed. Frequent water breaks are a part of our daily routine.

lodging **LODGING**

All 2010 Golf Schools are DAY CAMPS ONLY. However, we will be glad to assist out of town students with lodging information. Please call Chip Watson, Director of School Services at 919-846-1536.

skill level **SKILL LEVEL**

All skill levels (beginner, intermediate, and advanced) are welcome at any golf school week. The student's skill level and age are taken into consideration when making groups. The teacher - student ratio is 5:1 which enables the staff to assist students of all skill levels improve their golf game. We also understand that siblings and friends are in golf school weeks together and every effort is made to accommodate group requests during group instruction time. We expect every student to improve and to have a fun time doing it.

eligibility **ELIGIBILITY**

In order to accommodate the growing number of year round school schedules, some golf school age groups have been expanded from past years to allow more options for all ages.

June 14-17, 2010 Session Wildwood Green Golf Club

Open to boys and girls ages 6-18. Under NCAA rules, any student who has not started college is eligible. This is a Day Camp Only and the hours will be 9:00 am - 1:00 pm daily. Lunch is provided each day. Teacher - student ratio is 5:1.

June 21-24, 2010 Session Wildwood Green Golf Club

Open to boys and girls ages 6-18. Under NCAA rules, any student who has not started college is eligible. This is a Day Camp Only and the hours will be 9:00 am - 1:00 pm daily. Lunch is provided each day. Teacher - student ratio is 5:1.

June 28-July 1, 2010 Session Wildwood Green Golf Club

Open to boys and girls ages 9-18. Under NCAA rules, any student who has not started college is eligible. This is a DAY CAMP ONLY and the hours will be 9:00 am - 4:00 pm, with the camp ending Thursday at 4:00 pm. Lunch is provided each day. Teacher - student ratio is 5:1.

July 5-8, 2010 Session Lonnie Poole Golf Course at NC State

Open to boys and girls ages 6-18. Under NCAA rules, any student who has not started college is eligible. This is a Day Camp Only and the hours will be 9:00 am - 1:00 pm daily. Lunch is provided each day. Teacher - student ratio is 5:1.

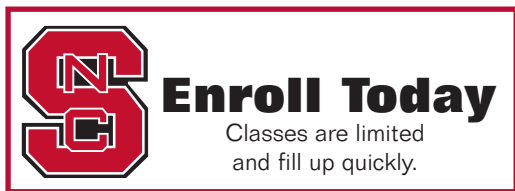
